“Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.” Isaiah 41:10

There are days when the weight of life feels especially heavy. Responsibilities press in, worries linger, and strength seems to fade. In such moments, God’s Word speaks with clarity and comfort: “Fear thou not; for I am with thee.”

Notice that God does not say we will never face difficulty. Instead, He assures us of His presence in the midst of it. We are not left to carry our burdens alone. The Creator of heaven and earth walks beside us, offering His strength in place of our weakness.

Three promises stand out in this verse: “I will strengthen thee... I will help thee... I will uphold thee.” These are not uncertain hopes, they are firm assurances from a faithful God. When our strength runs out, His does not. When we feel like falling, He upholds us with His righteous hand.

This week, when you feel weary or discouraged, remember that your strength is not found within yourself alone. Turn to the Lord in prayer. Lean on His promises. Even a quiet moment of surrender can renew your spirit and remind you that you are held securely in His care.
